



## RFA Coaching Grants

The RFA will consider applications for grants towards the costs of attendance at Level 1 and Level 2 coaching courses.

These will be considered on the following basis. Please read and then complete the form overleaf.

- All applicants must be a fully paid up individual member of the RFA (formerly the Rugby Fives Association)
- Applicants who work at schools would be expected to approach the school first for funding
- Applications to the RFA must include details of how the applicant intends to use the qualification and their plans for opening up avenues for new players to be introduced to the game
- For qualifying applications, the RFA will pay 50% of the course costs and, if appropriate, travel and accommodation costs. This grant will be reclaimed by the RFA if the applicant does not either complete the course or obtain the qualification
- The remaining 50% is to be paid by the individual before commencing the course
- The RFA will also consider reimbursing the individual's contribution once there is evidence that their plans have been successfully put into practice
